



#### Overall structure of the RAI Tool

Composed of 5 sections:



**ID** card – Basic information on the agribusiness' profile;



**Scoping questions** – To adjust indicators to the agribusiness' profile;



**Practices** – Looking at operations, practices and procedures along 7 Dimensions:



**Outcomes** – Limited set of outputs and outcomes indicators, aligned with CSAF;



**Dashboards** – to visualize key results.

2C.1. The organization has a grievance mechanism that is easily accessible to its stakeholders, and adapted to their needs.



2C.1.1. The channels for complaints and responses are adapted to stakeholders' profiles and needs.



2C.1.1.1. Stakeholders have the choice between at least two channels, with at least one of these channels being with live, human interaction.

The RAI Tool allows for filtering in and out indicators based on the profile of an agribusiness.


## Scoring
